TITLE: **MESTIZO ARTS and ACTIVISM**

Applicant: Rosemarie Hunter, University Neighborhood Partners, Salt Lake City, UT

Abstract: A digital storytelling project designed to explore the relationship between access to higher education, and the educational, social, economic and geographical barriers faced by young people in Salt Lake's Westside neighborhoods.

Award: \$2,500

TITLE: **SENDING MESSAGES: TRUE STORIES FROM a SECURE CARE FACILITY**

Applicant: Virginia Pearce, Spy Hop Productions, Salt Lake City, UT

Abstract: A nine month project in which students write, edit, and record their own monthly radio show from a secure corrections facility in Utah. Students work with a Granite High School English teacher developing themes and writing scripts.

Award: \$4,500

TITLE: **ODYSSEY HOUSE NEIGHBORHOOD HISTORY TEEN APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM**

Applicant: Victoria Lyons, Bad Dog Arts Salt Lake City, UT

Abstract: An oral history-digital photography project in which low-income teens residing at Odyssey House will interview local business owners and create a historical legacy that benefits the whole community.
