Saturday, October 25 is the beginning of Banned Books Week. In a magazine I saw the list of some of the books on this list as to why they were banned. I thought you might be interested so here's the list. Considered too political were *Uncle Tom's Cabin*, *A Farewell to Arms*, *Animal Farm*, and *In the Spirit of Crazy Horse*. In the Irreligious category was *Lord of the Rings* and the *Harry Potter* series. Deemed socially offensive were *The Scarlet Letter*, *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*, *Gone with the Wind*, *Fahrenheit 451*, *To Kill a Mockingbird* and *James and the Giant Peach*. I'm going to have to read a few of these titles to see what it was that I missed.

Teen book group met last week to discuss *Seedfolks* by Paul Fleischman. I think on a whole the book was well received with some liking it more than others. We read an article about a teen book group at the Highland Library. It was interesting because the Delta City Library received a grant a couple of years ago to purchase 20 sets of 20 titles for our teen group. After our group read the books we sent them on to the Utah Humanities Council where they are housed and available for other book groups around the state. The Highland Library got their books from UHC. Now the Highland Library has received a grant to purchase 15 sets of 10 titles which

we will be able to use and extend our teen book group! The article stated that their favorite books have been *The Book Thief*, *Snakehead* and *The Graveyard Book* which were also some of our teen's favorites.

The adult book group met last week also and really had a great discussion about the book, *Home Before Morning, an Army Nurse in Vietnam*. This was not an easy subject to read about and some of it was pretty graphic but most of the group was compelled to read it. There was a great discussion about Vietnam. Some of the group had firsthand knowledge of the war, the protesters and the home front while the younger members weren't too familiar. It was stated that they didn't learn much about it in school with their history classes. Next month we are reading *The Last Cowboy* by Jana Richards, a Utah author.

There are appropriate places to keep your library card when coming to the library and then there are some that aren't that appropriate. Unfortunately we've seen it all!

Did you ever finish the last book in the *Hunger Games* series - *Mockingjay*? What did you think? I'm not sure I was that impressed. It wasn't as good as the first two in the series in my humble opinion.
