Please note that Utah Humanities Grants are made possible by funding from the National Endowment for the Humanities. If Congress cuts appropriations to NEH, UH's grants and other programs are threatened. UH also receives an appropriation from the Utah State Legislature, which is vital to our statewide programming.

For this reason, we require that all UH grant recipients send a letter to: Senator Romney, Senator Lee, and the Representative in your district, as well as to your Utah state legislator and senator. The letters should announce your grant award and describe what is made possible by this funding. **Copies of these 5 letters should be sent to UH with your initial Cash Request Form. Grant funds will not be released until copies of all 5 letters have been received.**
